#### III. INFORMATION COORDINATORS REPORT:

Tommy Smoot stated there was one right-to-know request, three 30-day follow-up reports, and six spill reports. The 2023 Statewide LEPC Conference will be virtual on October 26 from 830a – 1230p. The State will be hosting the EMA Directors conference in the fall virtually. Tommy served as an evaluator for the Medina County LEPC exercise on February 8, which became a CISA Communications exercise. Tim completed the first-time filer's report. Tim has also been working on our LEPC nominations for membership for the SERC to consider for their August 9<sup>th</sup> meeting. Please let Tim know if you cannot serve on LEPC for the next two years. Tier II reports are complete. We received our reimbursement for the FY22 PUCO grant. HazMat completed the first training funded by the FY22 HMEP - Year 1, Drug IQ, last week. We submitted the FY22 HMEP Year 2 grant application to Ohio EMA. There will be four comprehensive trainings for \$52,950. HMEP will fund 80%; if awarded, we asked LEPC to support the 20% match of \$10,590.

### IV. SPECIAL TEAMS PLANNER REPORT – Tim Gemind

Tim Gemind stated March's Hazmat training was Hazmat Emergency Response Decision Making. April's training was Clandestine Lab. May's training was Drug IQ, and June's training will be Homemade Explosives. July is TBD.



# **V. OLD BUSINESS**

Tim Gemind stated there were 722 Tier II submissions. There were significantly few manual submissions, and nine were late. Tim said regarding first-time filers, 52 is high. This number is usually in the teens. But most were oil wells.

Regarding the LEPC Annual Fall Conference, Tim has reached out to Portage and Stark County and heard nothing from either one. He is looking for suggestions. The committee decided to do a conference in 2024.
