This free course includes disaster preparedness activities as well as fire safety information.

**CERT Curriculum:**

1. Identifying potential hazards in the home and workplace
2. Developing plans to prepare families, businesses for disasters
3. Learning skills to help until professional responders arrive
4. Developing fire safety skills
5. Identifying hazardous materials
6. Understanding the psychological impact to disaster victims
7. American Red Cross CPR, AED, First Aid
8. Community Anti-Terrorism Awareness (CAT Eyes)
