Restaurant robber pleads guilty

(February 5, 2009, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today Kaymar D. Brown, 21, of Akron, pled guilty today to Aggravated Robbery, a felony of the first degree, with a Firearm Specification, Failure to Comply with the Order or Signal of a Police Officer, a felony of the third degree, and Having Weapons While Under Disability, a felony of the third degree.

Judge Alison McCarty will sentence Brown on March 12, 2009. He faces up to 23 years in prison.

On October 5, 2008, Brown entered the Arthur Treachers on E. Waterloo Road, Akron, approached the counter, pointed a gun at the clerk and demanded money. He then ordered the clerks to the back of the store, where the manager was located, and ordered the manager to enter the room where the safe was located. Brown then demanded more money from the safe. When he pulled his gun a young boy and his mother were close by, inside the restaurant. After the robbery, Brown ran with \$440.00 cash and led police on a chase that resulted in a crash. Kaymar D. Brown also had warrants for his arrest out of the State of New York.
