15 to Life for Akron Man Who Shot and Killed Boyhood Friend

(June 15, 2012... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a jury found Christopher C. Meadows, 28, of Longview Avenue in Akron, guilty of Murder and Felonious Assault, a felony of the second degree. Judge Tom Parker immediately sentenced Meadows to life in prison. Meadows will be eligible for parole in 2027.

In early December, Meadows got into an argument with Tramein Walker, a man with whom Meadows had grown up. Meadows ended the argument by shooting Walker twice, once in the back and once in the leg. Walker died of his injuries.
