Stitt Sentenced to Seven Years in Prison for Domestic Violence

(March 28, 2012... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that late Friday, March 23, Aaron Stitt, 24, of Brown Street in Akron, pleaded guilty to Aggravated Burglary, a felony of the first degree; Domestic Violence, a felony of the fourth degree; and Violating a Protection Order, a felony of the third degree. Judge Paul Gallagher sentenced Stitt to seven years in prison.

Stitt climbed through the window of his female victim's home and assaulted her early one morning in November. The woman, who has a child with Stitt, had a civil protection order against Stitt.

Eleven years ago, when Stitt was just 13, he shot and killed his father after years of abuse. Stitt admitted to a charge of Voluntary Manslaughter in Juvenile Court and spent approximately 2 ½ years in the Department of Youth Services.
