Akron Woman Pleads Guilty to Stabbing Boyfriend to Death

AKRON, Ohio (Friday, July 17, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Mareshah Livingston, 24, of Everton Drive in Akron, pled guilty in connection with the stabbing death of her boyfriend.

Livingston pled guilty to the following charge:

- Voluntary Manslaughter, a felony of the first degree

On October 16, 2014, Livingston fought and argued with her boyfriend, 23-year-old David Hart, at Livingston's Everton Road home. Livingston stabbed Hart once in the chest with a knife.

Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Todd McKenney is scheduled to sentence Livingston on August 26th at 9am.
