Tallmadge Man Sentenced to Prison for Driving Under the Influence of Drugs

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, October 05, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that visiting Judge James Kimbler sentenced Craig Consilio, 52, of Beachler Road in Tallmadge, to six years in prison for driving under the influence and possessing heroin.

On July 26, 2016, a Summit County jury found Consilio guilty of the following charges:

- Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence with Specification Concerning Operating Under the Influence – a felony of the 3rd degree
- Possession of Heroin – a felony of the 5th degree
- Driving Under Suspension – a misdemeanor of the 1st degree

On October 22, 2015, Consilio was driving on Vernon Odom Boulevard in Akron when he crossed over into oncoming traffic, lost control and flipped his car. The vehicle ended up on its side in the front yard of a home. It was later determined Consilio was under the influence of heroin, cocaine, and methamphetamines at the time. Investigators also found heroin and hypodermic needles in the vehicle.

This is Consilio's 5th OVI conviction in the past 20 years.
