Man Stuck by Vehicle

On January 29, 2019, at approximately 3:20 p.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call in regards to a pedestrian that was struck by a vehicle on Lockwood Road in Coventry Township. The Summit County Sheriff's Office and the Summit Metro Crash Response Team responded to the scene. Investigators determined that a 2003 Ford Focus was traveling westbound on Lockwood Road when it struck a man crossing the street. The man was identified as a 94 year old male from Coventry Township. The Coventry Fire Department responded and transported the man to Akron General Hospital. He was pronounced dead at the hospital a short time later. The road remained closed for approximately three hours. Neither speed nor alcohol appear to be factors in the incident.

Charges are pending the outcome of the investigation.
