Child Running in Roadway in Coventry

On Friday May 11, 2018, the Summit County Sheriff's Office was contacted in regards to a child running in the road in Coventry Township. The Summit County Sheriff's Detective Bureau and Patrol Units responded to the area. At approximately 4:45 p.m. a child described as a black male, approximately 8 years old, wearing only green shorts and socks was seen exiting a black Chevrolet Cavalier at the corner of Manchester Road and East State Street in Coventry Township. The child began running southbound on Manchester Road while being chased by what appeared to be an elderly white male. The white male had been driving the Chevrolet Cavalier. The child ran past St. Francis Church and stopped in the front yard of a residence on Manchester Road. A white Kia Soul stopped and the boy began running northbound on Manchester Road towards East State Street.
