Coventry Arrest

In May of 2017, the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to Akron Children's Hospital in regards to allegations of child that was assaulted by a family friend. It was alleged that on May 2, Audrey Hunt offered to watch her friend's 10 month old child for "a few hours." The mother of the child consented to the request. Later that day, the child's mother repeatedly contacted Hunt to have the child returned to her. Hunt indicated that she would return the child the next morning. On May 3, at approximately 7:00 p.m., after numerous attempts to have the child returned, the mother of the child got a ride to Hunt's residence. Upon her arrival, she noticed injuries to the child's face and arms. The mother of the child subsequently took the child to the hospital for an examination. It was determined that the injuries were consistent with physical abuse.

On Tuesday, June 20, Audrey D. Hunt, age 35 of Coventry Township was arrested and charged with Interference with Custody (F-4), Child Endangering (M-1), and Assault (M-1). She was transported to the Summit County Jail.
