7/6/2018 PRESS RELEASE Warrant Issued for Manslaughter

On June 4, 2017, the Summit County Sheriff's Office and Coventry Fire Department responded to the Taco Bell located at 3333 Manchester Road in Coventry Township in regards to an unresponsive male. When they arrived, they found a 31 year old male in the parking lot. The male was treated on scene for a drug overdose and later transported to Barberton Hospital, where he later died. The Summit County Medical Examiner's Office confirmed that the man died as a result of a Carfentanil/methamphetamine overdose.

The Sheriff's Office conducted a yearlong investigation into his death and concluded that Amar Ellies provided the above individual with drugs prior to his death. Ellies is 23 years old and his last known address is in Akron.

On July 5, 2018, arrest warrants were issued for Amar Ellies for Involuntary Manslaughter (F-1) and Corrupting Another with Drugs (F-2).

Ellies has not yet been located by authorities. Anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Ellies should contact the Summit County Sheriff's Office.
