Arrest Made in Akron

In July of 2017, the Summit County Sheriff's Office Detective assigned to investigate crimes against persons with developmental disabilities was notified of allegations of credit card theft in Akron. The Sheriff's detective initiated an investigation into the alleged theft of a credit card belonging to a 53 year old female with developmental disabilities.

The suspect, identified as Sierra Burros, allegedly stole the victim's credit card and used it to make over \$1,800 in purchases at area stores. Burros had been working as a home health aid.

On July 14, 2017, Sierra Burros, age 22 of Akron was arrested and charged with Theft from the Disabled (F-4) and Misuse of a Credit Card (F-4). She was booked into the Summit County Jail.
