### **Arrest Made in Coventry Traffic Fatality**

On Sunday, May 28, 2017, at approximately 4:45 p.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to a crash in Coventry Township. The crash occurred on South Main Street near the intersection of Leicester Drive. At approximately 4:43 p.m., a 1999 Ford Escort driven by a 24 year old New Franklin woman, later identified as Natasha Boggs, traveled over the fog line and struck 3 children walking northbound on South Main Street. The Coventry Fire Department responded to the scene. A 14 year old female from Akron was pronounced dead at the scene. A 14 year old female from Coventry Township was transported to the Akron General Medical Center, where she later died from injuries sustained in the accident. A 15 year old male from Coventry Township was transported to Akron Children's Hospital with serious injuries. The Summit Metro Crash Response Team responded to investigate the crash.

A thorough investigation was conducted by the Summit Metro Crash Response Team. On July 14, Natasha R. Boggs, age 24 of New Franklin was arrested and charged with (2) counts of Involuntary Manslaughter (F-3), (2) counts of Vehicular Homicide (M-1), (1) count of Tampering with Records (F-3), (1) count of Vehicular Assault (M-1), (1) count of Driving While Texting (MM), and (1) count of Marked Lanes (M-3). Boggs was transported to the Summit County Jail.
