Green High School Lockdown

On October 6, 2017, the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of threats of violence at Green High School. It was reported that a 17 year old student posted pictures and made threats on social media. The student claimed to be at the high school at the time of the post. Green High School was locked-down and Sheriff's Office personnel completed a thorough search of the school. The suspect was subsequently located at an Akron address. The lockdown was lifted at approximately 9:50 a.m.

Charges may be pending the outcome of the investigation.
