Arrest Made for Sex Offense

On October 16, 2018, at approximately 8:15 a.m., the Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to Chaffin Road in Coventry Township in regards to a report of a male in the backyard of a residence removing his clothing and masturbating. Sheriff's Deputies located and identified the male as Daniel R. Withrow.

Subsequent to the investigation, it was determined that Withrow attempted to break into an East Waterloo Road apartment earlier in the morning (approximately 6:00 a.m.) and was confronted by the 68 year old female resident. Withrow fled and returned 20 minutes later to the same apartment. He opened the window and attempted to gain access. The female resident pushed him out of the window and he fled on foot. It was discovered that Withrow intended on having sexual intercourse with the female resident. As he was fleeing the area, he was noticed by the above Coventry resident and apprehended by deputies.

Withrow, age 49, of Akron was arrested and charged with Burglary (F-3), Voyeurism (M-3), and Public Indecency (M-3). He was booked into the Summit County Jail.
