ARREST MADE IN COVENTRY TOWNSHIP HUMAN REMAINS FINDING

The Summit County Sheriff's Office, along with the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office have tentatively identified the human remains found on December 9, as those of 54 year old Howard L. Eubank and have charged his wife, Marcia Y. Eubank with murder.

The Sheriff's Office received a call of possible human remains located in the area of 3301 Linda Street at 1:38 pm on December 9, 2017. Deputies responded and found what appeared to be deteriorated remains. The Summit County Medical Examiner's Office and Sheriff's Crime Scene units were notified and responded to the scene.

Through investigation, it was determined Mr. Eubank was killed earlier this year in the residence where the remains were located and this was a domestic related incident.

Marcia Eubank, age 49, the victim's wife, was not at the residence when deputies arrived at the scene. She was located and taken into custody without incident in the parking lot of a local business in the evening hours of December 9. She was then interviewed by Summit County Sheriff's Detectives and subsequently charged with one count of murder and booked into the Summit County Jail.

The autopsy will be performed this week at the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office.
