**Hungarian Club Break-in**

On December 16, 2018, at approximately 3:00 a.m., The Summit County Sheriff's Office responded to the Hungarian Club located at 697 East Waterloo Road in Coventry Township for a reported security alarm. Responding deputies checked the perimeter of the building and observed a male running in the parking lot with two pry bars and a safe. The male dropped these items and fled after being confronted by deputies. A foot pursuit ensued and a perimeter was established on the property. The Norton Police Department assisted with a K-9 unit and the suspect was located hiding nearby in a wooded area. The male was identified as Paul Barna, age 35 of Akron. He was arrested on charges of Breaking and Entering (F-5) and Possession of Criminal Tools (F-5). Barna was booked into the Summit County Jail.

The recovered property was returned to the Hungarian Club.
