Summit County Executive's Office will increase zero emission vehicles in our fleet, develop charging infrastructure and support efforts to build a more resilient electrical grid. We will leverage internal efforts to encourage residents, businesses and local governments to adopt electric vehicles and equitable charging infrastructure.

Goals:

- 1. Utilize completed fleet analysis to Increase light-duty registered electric vehicles in our fleet and county-wide by 2030.
- 2. Establish EV preference policy for county vehicles purchases by 2025.
- 3. Explore EV-Ready building codes and encourage local municipalities to incorporate equitable EV-Ready zoning in new construction and major renovations by 2026.
- 4. Continue to provide educational opportunities related to EV adoption and charging, including digital resources and in-person events, to residents, businesses, commercial property owners and nonprofits, with a special focus on those who face barriers to, and track key metrics of this engagement.
- 5. Engage local electric utilities in planning to expand our EV fleet to ensure there is sufficient capacity in the grid to accommodate this expansion and develop partnerships for future charging infrastructure opportunities.
