Authorizing the Executive to execute a contract with DocuPet, Corp., as Best Practical Source, for dog licensing software, for a three-year term, from 3/1/25 to 2/28/28, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00, for the Fiscal Office and the Office of Information Technology.

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Office and the Office of Information Technology have determined that it is necessary to replace the dog licensing program as the current program is outdated and OIT is unable to support it going forward; and

WHEREAs, DocuPet will allow users to purchase pet licenses and locate a missing pet through a secure online portal; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to enter into a contract with DocuPet, Corp., as Best Practical Source, for dog licensing software, for a three-year term, from 3/1/25 to 2/28/28, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00; and

WHEREAS, DocuPet, Corp. is the best practical source due to their presence in the government market, commitment to payment security, and current utilization by eight other Ohio counties, per the Fiscal Office; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Information Technology Board finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute a contract with DocuPet Corp., as Best Practical Source, for dog licensing software, for a three-year term, from 3/1/25 to 2/28/28, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the County of Summit Information Technology Board that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a contract with DocuPet, Corp., as Best Practical Source, for dog licensing software, for a three-year term, from 3/1/25 to 2/28/28, in an amount not to exceed \$135,000.00.
