WHEREAS, the County of Summit Information Technology Board finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the County Executive to execute a contract with Quadient Leasing USA, Inc., under NASPO/ValuePoint Contract #CTR058809, for the lease of USA Electronic Certified Mail equipment, for a 60-month term, from 1/1/25 to 12/31/29, in an amount not to exceed \$100,113.60;

SECTION 1
