

County of Summit – Q-165-1 Akron-Cleveland Road Sanitary Sewer Extension

Request for Public Comment; March 4, 2026

The Summit County Department of Sanitary Sewer Services is implementing plans to extend sanitary sewers in Boston Township, Stow, and Cuyahoga Falls. Summit County has requested approximately \$3,000,000.00 from the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) for this project to extend sanitary sewers on Akron-Cleveland Road and Seasons Road for a total of roughly 4000 feet.

Ohio EPA will administer loan preparation based on state standards and Ohio EPA procedures. Construction will be by contractors selected by the County's competitive bidding process.

Sewer rates will not change due to this project. Summit County qualifies for the standard interest rate, which is currently 3.21% for a 20-year loan. Construction will begin in the Spring of 2026 and be completed by the beginning of 2027.
