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I. INTRODUCTIONS

This meeting of the Summit County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) was called to order by Steve Groves at 8:32 am on August 15, 2024, in the EOC, 166 S. High St., Basement.

II. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

Approval of Minutes – May 23, 2024

The motion was carried by voice vote.

Correspondence and Comments:

Steve Groves reviewed and passed around the correspondence:

- We received a resource request letter from the US EPA. They are developing a Cleveland/Central Lake Erie Sub-Area Contingency Plan. We provided them with a list of what is on the water spill trailer.
- Letter to Chief Underwood denying the request to fund the purchase of a new spill trailer and laptop
- One electronic vote:
 - The Hazmat Branch applied for a training grant from PUCO. The award was for \$18,550, with a match request provided by the LEPC for \$9,275

III. INFORMATION COORDINATORS REPORT:

Tim Gemind stated we received one right-to-know request, five 30-day follow-up reports, and three spill reports.

IV. SPECIAL TEAMS PLANNER REPORT – Tim Gemind

Tim Gemind stated that the June Hazmat training was on Air monitoring. July's training was an additional in-service on the new SCBAs. August training will be Hazmat Tox Med. September will be the Ohio Fire Academy Chlorine Trailer (Train-the-Trainer). October will be the LEPC Conference, SCBA, and meter work.

V. OLD BUSINESS

Tim Gemind discussed the Rt. 8 incident, and the Hazmat Branch received a reimbursement of \$3,804.17.

Four Hazmat technicians attended the IAFC Hazmat Conference in Baltimore the first week of June.

Tim placed the chlorine adapter kits order, and the ship date has been pushed back three to four weeks. We hope to have them ready in time for the September training.



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NEW BUSINESS

Macedonia Royal Chemical Cost Recovery expenses submitted \$43,321.13, and the total request for the Hazmat branch is \$5,835.54.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

EHS Hazard Analysis Committee

Completed facility interviews at Dupont Multibase in Copley, National Aerospace Processing in Stow, McCann Plastics in Green, and HB Chemical/Ravago Warehouse in Twinsburg.

Spill Reporting Compliance

The NOV report was emailed, and Kurt Kollar discussed spills across Ohio.

Training, Education & Exercise Committee

The LEPC Conference will be at the Red Cross on Friday, October 4. We sent out an online registration this week and had 46 registrations. Chief Drabick from East Palestine will be a guest speaker, and Kurt Kollar will also present from the state EPA perspective. Please let Tim know if anyone might be interested in attending.

Planning Committee

Tim just received an email from Michelle asking if we are updating our LEPC plan; he will contact the planning committee in October.

Finance Committee

The LEPC Budget and expenses were emailed.

Bruce Koellner motioned for up to \$3,000 for the LEPC Conference/Workshop on 10/4/24, with Julie Harber as the second. The motion was carried by voice vote.
