Approval of minutes – August 12, 2025

Chief Leslie made a motion to approve the minutes from August 12, 2025, with Chief Pascu as the second. The motion was carried by voice vote.

David O'Neal mentioned it would be a good idea to send reminders out to other agencies about how callouts work and continue to send them out periodically.

HAZMAT

- Report submitted

- We are down one gas meter. We use MSA air monitoring equipment, and during the last calibration, it came back with an error code. We will try to fix it.

- Goodyear will be selling their chemical facility and will coordinate with County Hazmat before selling to do one last walkthrough.
- LEPC has approved four people to go to Texas for the Hazmat conference

> WATER

- Dive training at Springfield Lake with a demo of AquaEye. South (Green, Coventry, New Franklin, Springfield) got a grant to purchase 4. We want to look at getting one for the North.
- Mask tech class on January 6th would like to ask for half of the \$575 per student. (Tenney wants to lock in the price.) Chief Reinbolt stated he would need to know how many students.

OLD BUSINESS

Tim stated that we received the reimbursement check from Quality Carriers, the party responsible for the Barberton incident, for \$20,293.75.

With regards to the new 3816 Hazmat truck replacement, Tim, Andrew King, and Dwayne Marty went to Farber to look at their plant and discuss what they have to offer. After the visit, they decided that they were not a viable option for the new truck. The committee is going to meet on September 22nd to discuss the three companies that are left and discuss a plan/funding.

NEW BUSINESS

Chief Reinbolt discussed the housing of the TROT truck. Green is not stating they do not want to house the truck, but are asking if there are other options. Macedonia is no longer an option to house the truck. Chief Reinbolt stated Akron Fire has a plan, with a station that has people on call to staff the truck. Chief Leslie made a motion to move the TROT truck from Green to Akron Station 7 with Dennis Ragins as the second. The motion was carried by voice vote.
