Chief Reinbolt called the Summit County Special Operations Response Team (SCSORT) Executive Board meeting to order on Tuesday, December 9, 2025, at 10:10 am in the Summit Emergency Communications Center, 630 North Ave., Tallmadge, OH.

- **Approval of minutes – November 12, 2025**

Chief Leslie made a motion to approve the minutes from the November 12, 2025, meeting, with Tommy Smoot as the second. The motion was carried by voice vote.

- **Chairperson's Comments/Correspondence**

Chief Reinbolt reviewed and spoke on the correspondence.

- Two training reimbursements. Tommy Smoot made a motion to approve two training reimbursements for Paul Amonett (\$110 and \$165), with Chief Leslie seconding. The motion was approved by voice vote.
- Chief Pascu made a motion to approve Joseph Wagner (Hazmat) with Tommy Smoot as the second. The motion was approved by voice vote.

- **SORT DISPATCH**

David O'Neal discussed the Region V callout to Mahoning County. There was a discussion that Region V is a different type of request from the State of Ohio's Fire Chief's Response Plan. Fire Chiefs need to opt in to receive requests within CIMS. It is then incumbent on the Fire Chief to decide what equipment they can send. Chief Berczik received the Region V request. If you have Region V equipment, it must go. More discussion on how Region 5 will be rolled out will be required. Chief Leslie suggested a flow chart from Region V on how they are rolled out be developed. The county representative for the State Response Plan should attend this meeting.

David O'Neal would also like a meeting about an email from Chief Pascu regarding how Akron assets will be dispatched for SORT and Region 5 callouts. He would like to discuss the workflows.

Leigh-Ann stated they have some training for the supervisors scheduled to come out after the Bath incident regarding the MAC channel. Steve Bosso noted that they need to be able to listen to the MAC channels.
