Summit County Triangle Building to be dedicated as the Russell M. Pry Building

On Monday, July 31st, the Summit County Triangle Building, located at 1180 South Main St. in Akron, will be dedicated as the Russell M. Pry Building in honor of Summit County's late Executive Russ Pry.

The dedication will begin at 10 a.m. at 1180 South Main St. in Akron. The Department of Job and Family Services (DJFS), located on the first floor of the Triangle Building will delay opening on the 31st until noon, following the dedication ceremony, refreshments and tours.
