County Executive Shapiro Sponsors Habitat for Humanity's 200th Home in Summit County

On Tuesday, August 22, 2017, Summit County Executive Ilene Shapiro sponsored the groundbreaking at Habitat for Humanity of Summit County's 200th home. The Copley Township residence was funded, in part, by the Executive's Department of Community and Economic Development through the Home Investments Partnership Program funding.

The Summit County Executive's Office routinely partners with Habitat for Humanity to provide homes for low-income families and has helped house over 200 adults and over 375 children during the partnership. The 200th home was also sponsored by Circle K and its employees, who participated in the groundbreaking ceremony.

"Habitat for Humanity has changed the lives of hundreds of families in Summit County by giving them the opportunity to become homeowners," said County Executive Shapiro.
