During the Help a Puppy Get Lucky Event, adoption costs will be reduced to \$28 for dogs (regularly \$94) and \$10 for cats (regularly \$60) from Monday, March 14 till Friday, March 25. The animals will be fully vetted (bloodwork, flea treatments, intestinal de-worming, spay/neuter, and vaccinations) and ready to be taken home. Those who adopt a dog will receive a 2022 Summit County Dog License included in the adoption cost.
