County Executive Shapiro announces Purrride adoption event

SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO—The cats and dogs of Summit County Animal Control invite residents to celebrate Pride, an annual celebration of the LGBTQ+ community, with them this month. In honor of Pride, County Executive Ilene Shapiro is pleased to announce a special adoption event for June, Purrride! The event will run from Monday, June 5 to Friday, June 30. During the adoption event, costs will be reduced to \$28 for dogs (regularly \$94) and \$5 for cats (regularly \$60). The animals are microchipped, fully vetted (includes bloodwork, flea treatments, intestinal deworming, spay or neuter, and vaccinations) and ready to be taken home. Those who adopt a dog will also receive a 2023 Summit County Dog License included in the adoption cost.
