SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO—The dogs at Summit County Animal Control are cozy in their beds, wagging their tails, mouths watering at the thought of their Thanksgiving feast. As a token of their gratitude, Animal Control is reducing adoption prices throughout November.

During “FURever Thankful,” adoption costs will be reduced to \$28 for dogs (regularly \$94). All dogs are microchipped, fully vetted (including bloodwork, flea treatments, intestinal de-worming, spay or neuter, and vaccinations) and ready to be taken home. Those who adopt a dog will also receive a 2025 Summit County Dog License included in the adoption cost.
