County Executive and Animal Control Announce “Warm Up with a Pup!” Adoption Promotion

SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO—Summit County is inviting residents to warm their hearts and homes with a four-legged friend. To help our pups at Animal Control find loving homes during the colder months, County Executive Ilene Shapiro is announcing the “Warm Up with a Pup!” adoption event. Community members can visit Summit County Animal Control and find their cozy companion any day of the week from Wednesday, January 7 until Monday, February 2. Throughout this time, dog adoption fees will be reduced to \$28 (regularly \$94).

During the adoption event, all dogs are microchipped, fully vetted (including bloodwork, flea treatments, intestinal de-worming, spay or neuter, and vaccinations) and ready to be taken home. Those who adopt a dog will also receive a 2026 Summit County Dog License included in the adoption cost.
