### **Accomplice pleads guilty to Manslaughter for driving Murderer in Fatal Carjacking**

(December 8, 2009, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Robert Nunley, 21, of Akron, pled guilty today during his trial to Involuntary Manslaughter (with a gun specification), and Aggravated Robbery, for being part of a crime that left 26-year-old Jason Baker dead.

He was sentenced by Judge Allison McCarty to 15 years in prison.

On March 15, 2009, Nunley drove Jason Webster, 24, of Stow, to Montrose Avenue in Akron where Webster carjacked and murdered Jason Baker. The victim's brother identified Robert Nunley as the driver after finding his picture in a high school yearbook.

Webster was sentenced by Judge Alison McCarty to Life without Parole plus 82 years. He was also ordered to spend each March 15, the day he murdered Baker, in solitary confinement.
