(Columbus) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh was sworn in last evening as President of the Ohio Prosecuting Attorneys Association (OPAA).

After being sworn in, Walsh said "I am honored to serve as the new president of OPAA, an organization that has been in existence for more than 70 years and has been so effective at representing the interests and goals of prosecutors statewide.

"Our job as prosecutors is one of the greatest jobs you can have. Every day we fight for what is true, what is right, and what is just. We stand up for those who are beaten down. We are the champions of justice regardless of who the victims are, where they come from, or the lifestyle they lead. Our mission and our job are constant: We seek justice."

Walsh has been a member of OPAA for nine years, and has served on its Executive Board for the past five years as an officer of the board. OPAA is a private non-profit membership organization made up of the 88 county prosecutors. Attorney General Richard Cordray swore Ms. Walsh in at the ceremony, held in the Statehouse in Columbus.
