### **Man Sentenced to 12 Years for Multiple Stabbings**

(January 28, 2009, Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Judge Lynne Callahan sentenced Eugene Davis, 32, of Diagonal Road, Akron, to 12 years in prison for the stabbing of two men.

In January 2007, Davis attacked a man with a box cutter at the home of his ex-girlfriend. The victim was hospitalized with cuts to his face and hands. He was placed in intensive care for surgery on his hand.

While out on bond from that 2007 case, Davis attacked another man in August of 2008. Davis stabbed his second victim in the abdomen and hands with a kitchen knife. The victim was hospitalized and required numerous surgeries.

Davis pled guilty to two counts of Felonious Assault on January 5, 2009, shortly before his trial was to begin. Judge Callahan sentenced Davis to 6 years in prison for each incident and ordered that those sentences run consecutively for a total of 12 years.
