Jack Morrison's verdict returned

(July 29, 2009, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Jack Morrison, 56, of Silver Lake, was found guilty by Judge Judith Cross of Filing a False Financial Disclosure Statement and Falsification, both misdemeanors. He was found not guilty of Unlawful Interest in a Public Contract, three counts of Filing a False Financial Disclosure Statement, and Falsification, also misdemeanors.

He was sentenced by Judge Cross to one year probation and fined \$1,000.

Morrison was charged with seven misdemeanors for failing to disclose his interest in a house owned by his son, Jack Morrison, Jr., that was sold to the University of Akron. Morrison is a Trustee at the University of Akron. The Ohio Ethics Commission requested charges to be filed after an investigation into the sale.
