### **Murderer Sentenced to Life Plus Three Years**

(Akron, July 14, 2009) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Terry Lee Wilson, 43, of Barberton was sentenced by Judge Tom Parker to a total of Life plus three years for the Murder of Jason Reid. Wilson was found guilty by a jury on July 6.

Three defendants were charged in the crime: Terry Lee Wilson, David Zander, 30, of North Canton, and James Ware, 35, of Akron. On August 20, 2008, Jason Reid, 27, of Akron, was found behind a business in Barberton shot to death and robbed. On February 25, 2009, Zander was found guilty of one count of Aggravated Murder and was sentenced to life with parole eligibility in 25 years by Judge Robert Gippin. Zander lured the victim outside of the bar, where Wilson and alleged accomplice James Ware were waiting for him. Reid ran and was shot in the back and robbed.

James Ware is set to begin trial on August 20, 2009.
