### **Guilty Verdict for Accomplice in Murder**

(Akron, July 6, 2009) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Terry Lee Wilson, 43, of Barberton was found guilty Thursday, July 2, 2009 of **Aggravated Murder with a Firearm Speculation**, a special felony, for the murder of Jason Reid, 27, of Akron. He was also found guilty of **Aggravated Robbery**, a felony of the first degree, **Having Weapons Under Disability**, a felony of the third degree, **Trafficking Heroin**, a felony of the fifth degree, and two counts of **Possession of Cocaine**, felonies of the third and fifth degree.

Wilson will be sentenced by Judge Tom Parker on July 14, 2009 at 10 a.m.

Three defendants were charged in the crime: Terry Lee Wilson, David Zander, 30, of North Canton, and James Ware, 35, of Akron. On August 20, 2008, Jason Reid was found behind a business in Barberton shot to death and robbed. On February 25, 2009, Zander was found guilty of one count of Aggravated Murder and was sentenced to life with parole eligibility in 25 years by Judge Robert Gippin. Zander lured the victim outside of the bar, where Wilson and alleged accomplice James Ware were waiting for him. Reid ran and was chased by Wilson and Ware, and Wilson shot the victim in the back. They then robbed him.

James Ware is set to begin trial on August 20, 2009.
