Man Sentenced to 10 Years for Robbery, Assault on Elderly Woman

(Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that LaCarlos Revier, 37, of Sagamore Hills was sentenced yesterday to 10 years in prison by Judge Mary Rowlands after pleading guilty on April 8, 2009 to **Robbery**, and **Felonious Assault**, both felonies of the second degree, and **Aggravated Menacing** and **Hit Skip**, both first degree misdemeanors.

“This man punched a 74 year old woman in the face while trying to steal her purse,” said Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh. “Criminals who prey on the elderly are some of the most disturbing cases. I am pleased with the 10 year sentence, which was the amount of prison time we requested.”

On October 22, 2008, Marjorie Wolbert, 74, was leaving a Marc’s store in Sagamore Hills when Revier grabbed her purse. When Wolbert tried fighting Revier off, he punched her in the face with a starter pistol, causing a split in her upper lip that required surgery. A bystander tried stopping Revier, but backed off when Revier pointed the starter pistol at him. Revier then fled the scene.
