

## **MESSAGE FROM PROSECUTOR SHERRI BEVAN WALSH**

(Akron, November 6, 2009) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Donnie Grigg (36), of Akron, was found guilty by a jury of Burglary, a felony of the second degree. The jury deliberated only ten minutes before giving its verdict.

Grigg will be sentenced by Judge Tom Parker on November 24, 2009.

On August 10, 2009 Grigg was a resident at Oriana House when he talked another resident into being a lookout for him while he committed a break-in into the administrator's office which held files with client funds in them. Grigg told fellow resident Tyler Bellew that he would give him twenty dollars if Bellew would act as lookout for him. Grigg entered a small room which contained only a small sink while Bellew stood watch at the pay phone outside. Grigg stood on the sink and crawled up into the ceiling of CBCF. Once there, he made his way to the office of an administrator, dropped down through the ceiling and broke into a locked file cabinet. Grigg returned the same way he came, with Bellew acting as lookout the whole time.

Tyler Bellew pled guilty to Burglary, a felony of the fourth degree, and testified against Grigg. He was sentenced to one year in prison.
