Man Sentenced to 13 Years in Prison

(February 1, 2011, Akron) ... Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that David Flowers, 31, of Bye Street in Akron, was sentenced to 13 years in prison for domestic violence and numerous drug charges.

On January 5, 2011, Flowers was found guilty by a jury of Felonious Assault, a second degree felony with a Repeat Violent Offender Specification, Possession of Cocaine, a third degree felony, two counts of Trafficking in Cocaine, third degree felonies, Possession of Cocaine, a fourth degree felony, and Domestic Violence, a third degree felony.

On July 2, 2010, Flowers argued with the victim and punched her in the face. The victim then filed a police report.

On August, 12, 2010, while out on bond from assaulting the victim, Flowers convinced the victim to meet him at the home he shares with his brother. He became enraged when the victim wanted to leave. For several hours, Flowers punched, slapped and kicked the victim. He also scratched her neck, causing significant scarring, as well as bit the victim on her face and hands, causing a broken bone to the tip of her finger. The victim was able to escape the residence when Flowers fell asleep.
