Akron Man Guilty of Thanksgiving Assault

(February 24, 2012... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a jury found Craig L. Humbert, 33, of Fern Street in Akron, guilty of Domestic Violence, a felony of the fourth degree, and Violating a Protection Order, a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Humbert became angry with his mother while she cooked Thanksgiving dinner at his apartment. Humbert punched his mother and then tried to choke her and throw her over a banister while his six-year-old nephew screamed for Humbert to stop. After kicking his mother in the pelvis, Humbert left the apartment. The victim called the Akron Police Department and filed a temporary protection order against her son. Humbert violated that order by showing up at the victim's apartment a few days later.

Judge Judy Hunter will sentence Humbert on March 27 at 9:00 a.m.
