Akron Man to Spend 10 Years in Prison for Child Porn and Meth

(April 25, 2013... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Judge Tammy O'Brien sentenced Jesse Jack Guyton, 34, of Nola Lane in Akron, to 10 years in prison on meth and child porn charges.

The Ohio Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force obtained a search warrant for Guyton's home and computer after discovering sexually explicit photos he posted on a file-sharing site. While executing the search warrant, officers found an active meth lab in his basement. The Summit County Sheriff's Office found on Guyton's computer more than 500 videos and thousands of photos involving children between the ages of two and 12 engaged in sexual activity.

Guyton pleaded guilty on March 21 to Manufacturing Methamphetamine, a felony of the first degree; Pandering Sexually Oriented Material Involving a Minor, a felony of the second degree; and five counts of Pandering Sexually Oriented Material Involving a Minor, a felony of the fourth degree. Guyton will be a Tier II sex offender when he is released from prison, meaning he will have to register his address with the Sheriff in the county in which he resides every six months for 25 years.
