Springfield Township Woman Pleads Guilty to Murdering Boyfriend

(February 20, 2013... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that late yesterday Sharon Hall, 51, of Gregory Drive in Springfield Township, pleaded guilty to Involuntary Manslaughter, a felony of the first degree with a gun specification.

Hall shot her live-in boyfriend, 55-year-old James Cody, multiple times in their home on July 12, 2012. He was dead when first-responders arrived.

Judge Judy Hunter will sentence Hall on March 26 at 1:30 p.m. Hall faces six to 14 years in prison, all of which is mandatory time, meaning she cannot apply for early release.
