Akron Woman Pleads Guilty in Heroin Deaths

(October 15, 2013... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Danielle M. Hoover, 30, of S. Bender Road in Akron, pleaded guilty to two counts of Involuntary Manslaughter, felonies of the first degree.

On two separate occasions, one in September 2009 and one in December 2012, men overdosed on heroin and died while with Hoover. Each time, Hoover provided the heroin, which she purchased with the victim's money. The two got high together, and then the man overdosed and died. And each time, Hoover fled instead of trying to get help for the men.

Judge Amy Corrigan Jones will sentence Hoover on November 19 at 10:00 a.m.
