14 Years in Prison for Tyree Feaster

(August 21, 2014... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Judge Alison McCarty sentenced Tyree Feaster 24, of Boulevard Avenue in Akron, to fourteen years in prison. Feaster pleaded guilty to Aggravated Burglary and Aggravated Robbery with a gun.

On October 16, 2013, Feaster and Jackson arranged for two female co-defendants to enter the victim's home. Once inside, they allowed Feaster and Jackson to enter and rob him. Both men had guns and pistol whipped the victim. Jackson then forced the victim into his car and drove around trying to obtain cash. Feaster and the female co-defendants stole the victim's TV, clothes and shoes before fleeing in a different vehicle. The victim was able to escape when Jackson saw the police and jumped from the vehicle.

Co-defendants Katrina Collins, 19, of Everton Drive in Akron, and Shyann Cherry, 19, of Baird Street in Akron, pleaded guilty to Aggravated Robbery. Travaski Jackson, 24, of Garfield Avenue in Akron, was found guilty after trial of Aggravated Burglary, Aggravated Robbery, Kidnapping, all with a guns and having weapons while under disability.
