### **Akron Cousins Guilty of Robbing Game Rack**

(February 25, 2014... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a jury found Duane A. Clayton, 31, of Tioga Avenue in Akron, guilty of Aggravated Robbery, a felony of the first degree, with a firearm specification.

On September 18, Clayton and his cousin, 20-year-old Myron Clayton-Foster, robbed the Game Rack on Goodyear Blvd of several games and money. With the assistance of the K-9 Unit, police were able to track Clayton to the basement of a nearby residence. The stolen items were found with some of Clayton's clothing in the yard of the building.

Judge Lynne Callahan will sentence Clayton on April 2. Clayton-Foster, of Dover Avenue in Akron, previously pleaded guilty to Aggravated Robbery, a felony of the first degree, with a firearm specification. He is scheduled to be sentenced on February 26.
