Kyle Spy Guilty of Murdering Terry Iverson

(June 24, 2014... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that a jury found Kyle J. Spy, 24, of Brandon Avenue in Akron, guilty of Murder with a firearm specification. Spy pleaded guilty to Having Weapons Under Disability, a felony of the third degree, on June 17 right before the trial started. He was immediately sentenced to 36 months in prison.

On the evening of May 16, 2013, Spy was at a party on Wildwood Avenue in Akron. One of Spy's friends left the party to grab some food. When she returned, she sat in her car talking through the driver's side window to 23-year-old Terry Iverson for a few minutes. As Iverson walked away from the car, Spy approached and shot Iverson six times. Spy then fled from the scene. Iverson was pronounced dead at Akron General Medical Center. Spy was arrested the next morning.

Judge Amy Corrigan Jones will sentence Spy on Thursday, June 26 at 10:00 a.m.
