Man Guilty of Drive-By Shooting Murder

(November 6, 2014... Akron) ... Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that late yesterday a jury found Nathaneal Carter, 33, of Marcy Street in Akron, guilty of:

- Murder, a special felony, with two firearm specifications
- Two counts of Felonious Assault, a felonies of the second degree, each with two firearm specifications
- Having Weapons while under Disability, a felony of the third degree
- Tampering with Evidence, a felony of the third degree

On June 11th, 2014, Donald Carter Jr., 18, was killed by gunshot at his friend's Cole Avenue home. Donald was visiting his friend, Dana Williams, when Nathaneal Carter drove by in his girlfriend's red Santa Fe, opening fire. Williams was uninjured but one bullet struck Donald Carter in the back, killing him as he tried to get away. Donald retreated to the backyard where he died.

Judge Gallagher will sentence Carter on Wednesday, December 17 at 9:30a.m.
