Akron Man Sentenced to Prison for Domestic Violence & Making Illegal Fireworks

AKRON, Ohio (Wednesday, August 24, 2016) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Paul Gallagher sentenced Paul Plazak, 52, of Chalker Street in Akron, to two years in prison.

On June 29, 2016 Plazak pled guilty to the following charges:

- Domestic Violence – a felony of the 3rd degree
- Illegal Manufacture of Fireworks – a felony of the 3rd degree

On May 4, 2016, Akron police responded to Plazak's home on Chalker Street for a report of a domestic violence incident. Upon arrival, Officers were directed to the home's basement, where they discovered over 1,000 homemade fireworks. The bomb squad was called to help secure the scene.
