Akron Man Sentenced After Placing Hidden Cameras in Bathrooms

AKRON, Ohio (Tuesday, August 11, 2015) – Summit County Prosecutor Sherri Bevan Walsh announced today that Summit County Common Pleas Court Judge Christine Croce sentenced Curtis Von Tacky, 33, of South Meadowcroft Drive in Akron, to 17 months in prison, one month short of the maximum sentence.

On June 1st, 2015, Von Tacky pled guilty to the following charges:

- Two Counts of Voyeurism – misdemeanors of the second degree
- Attempted Tampering of Evidence – a felony of the fourth degree

In May of 2014, Von Tacky was employed at a Summit County business where he hid an iPhone in a tissue box in a women's restroom. A woman discovered the phone and handed it over to her boss. Von Tacky admitted to investigators that the phone was his, then took the phone and deleted the images. Then, in September of 2014, while already facing charges from the May incident, Von Tacky placed another camera in a women's bathroom at the Portage Country Club. That camera was discovered by a woman who later notified police. The phone disappeared after a Country Club manager left it unattended in an open office. Von Tacky later admitted to taking the phone and deleting the contents.

Von Tacky was also designated a Tier I sex offender and will have to register with the local sheriff once a year for 15 years.
